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ELECTION PROCEDURE

1. Send Nomination forms to all members with the Annual Report.
2. Members must complete nomination forms and must be placed in a box situated in the Mission Centre on the AGM day only.
3. The AGM elects an Election Board consisting of a Chairman and two members. The Election Board members are not eligible to stand for election for any post in the current year.
4. The Election Board chairman opens the box and must read out the list of nominations.
5. The Election Board chairman asks for further nominations for vacant post and for any withdrawals.
6. If more than one nomination has been received for an official post, then the Election Board prepare ballot papers and carry out the election of the officials first.
7. Election Board must carry out the election of committee members if required and include any candidate who failed to be elected as an official but wishes to compete for the committee member post.
8. Candidates for official posts will be given one minute each to make a speech justifying their capability to fulfil the relevant post before the election.
9. A member can only be nominated for one post except for situation mentioned in (7).
10. The three members of the Election Board should independently count the votes before announcing the results.
11. All Ballot papers must have the signature of the Chairman of the Election Board.
